The Benefits of holding Big Draw Swindon:


- unique free event will contribute to Swindon Borough Council's Swindon Does Arts campaign to increase the number of adults participating in the arts, and meet NI11 expectations

- engage members of the public in an inclusive, accessible, fun and creative activity
- raise the profile of drawing and develop a community of 'urban sketchers'
- a catalyst for future drawing / visual arts based events and activities in Swindon.

Planned activities:

- a wall display of advertising POS materials (donated by the stores) to illustrate the theme, and market Outlet stores
- drawing activities for young children (floor-based, crayons)

drawing activities for all ages

- a series of still life set-ups made up of items loaned by Outlet stores (with acknowledgment/marketing materials)
- a series of white-painted objects to be used as blank canvases
- dot to dot drawing activity (Outlet store based)
- gallery wall (+ legacy exhibitions)
